The Reformed Presbyterian Church of Bangladesh Synod has approximately 60 members. It meets in May and December with a conference for three days of biblical input and meetings on the fourth day. Teaching at the conference is conducted by APWM-approved lecturers.

APWM partners with the Reformed Presbyterian Church of Bangladesh by providing support for the Presbyterian Theological College at Gazipur. The college has approximately 35 students spread over first and second year and a pre-theology semester. There are 4 full-time lecturing staff and 4 part-time members plus other members of the college, making up about 70 personnel.

Discipleship Training Centres are based in 7 areas of the country where 56 evangelists work.

Outreach takes place in Sylet, Shatkira, Dinajpur, Khargrocheri with potential areas being Nilpharmary, Jamalapur and Gazipur.

In 2009 the Church had one school. Today there are approximately 37 schools throughout the country with about 2000 students. These cater for poor children with some classes in rooms and others in the open air. 'Friday Schools' are also part of the ministry.

The Bangladesh Bible Correspondence Institute has been established, with James Rana and Ajoy Das heading up the work and working with the Pakistan Bible Correspondence Institute.
